## READINGS FOR THE WEEK

### Seventh Sunday of Easter:

Acts 1:12-14, Ps 27:1, 4, 7-8, 1Pt 4:13-16, Jn 17: 1-11a; Jesus, having completed the work of his Father, speaks of returning to him and of being glorified (3). As we share in Christ's glory, so too do we share in his suffering (2). We have nothing to fear, however, since the Lord is our refuge (Ps). In his name we gather (1), attentive to the Spirit.

**Monday:** Acts 19:1-8, Ps 68:2-7, Jn 16:29-33.

Professing their belief in Jesus (2), the disciples found in Ephesus are baptized (1). They rejoice and are glad (Ps) in the Holy Spirit.

**Tuesday:** Acts 20:17-27, Ps 68:10-11, 20-21, Jn 17:1-11a.

Jesus prays for his disciples (2) that their needs might be met (Ps). Paul bears witness to the movement of the Spirit in his own life (1).

**Wednesday:** Acts 20:28-38, (Ps) 68:29-30, 33-36b, Jn 17:11b-19.

Paul prays that the elders will keep watch over the church in Ephesus (1). Jesus prays that his father will show forth his power (Ps) and guard and protect his disciples (2).

**Thursday:** Acts 22:30; 23:6-11. Ps 16:1-2a, 5, 7-11, Jn 17:20-26.

The Lord encourages (Ps) Paul in jail and speaks of his mission to Rome (1) in order that even the center of the Gentile world will come to believe in God's only son (2).

**Friday:** Acts 25:13b-21,

Ps 103:1-2, 11-12, 19-20b, Jn 21:15-19.

Jesus appears to Peter (2). Paul proclaims him to be risen and alive (1), and the Lord of all (Ps).

**Saturday:** Acts 28:16-20, 30-31, Ps 11:4-5, 7; Jn 21:20-25.

Along with Saul, Barnabas is set apart (1) to preach the Good News to the nations (Ps). To lie is forbidden by Jesus (2).

### Glorious and Prayerful Presence

Jesus prays for his disciples in Sunday's Gospel. The setting is the Last Supper, where Jesus has been speaking to his disciples about his impending departure, while also assuring them that the Paraclete will come to be with them. The prayer, while directed to the Father, is spoken in the hearing of the disciples, and concludes the Supper. It has

three parts: Jesus prays first for himself (vv. 1-5), then for those who already believe in him (vv. 6-19) and finally for all believers (vv. 20-26).

In the Fourth Gospel, it is the Word become flesh and dwelling among us that makes the divine glory, God's impressive presence, visible to us, (John 1:14). When Jesus begins to reveal his glory publicly in signs at the wedding feast of Cana, the disciples perceive these as concrete manifestations of God's presence and come to believe in Jesus (John 2:11). Now, as he is about to depart, Jesus speaks to God of how he has glorified God on earth – that is, has manifested the divine presence through his impressive deeds – and asks, "Now glorify me, Father, with you, with the glory that I had with you before the world began" (John 17:5). He is now entering another moment in his way of being with God and with humankind, and it is his disciples who will make God's presence on earth. Jesus is already abiding in them. He affirms this, saying, "I have been glorified in them" (John 17:10).

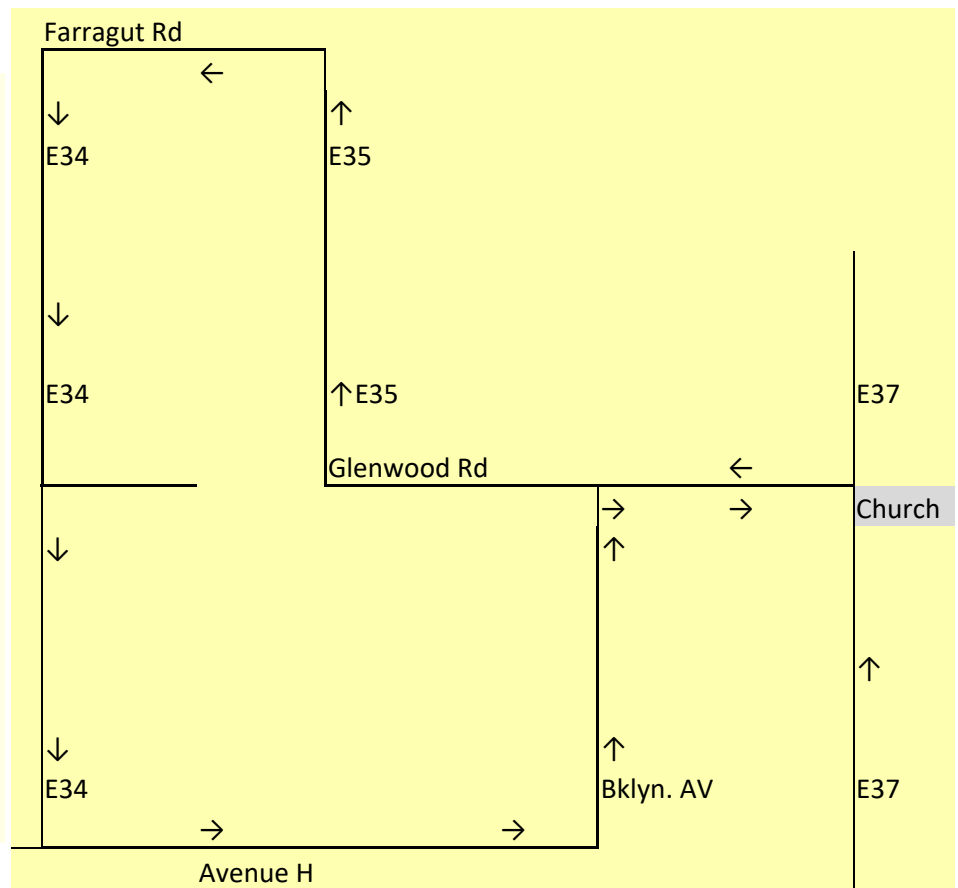

### Route

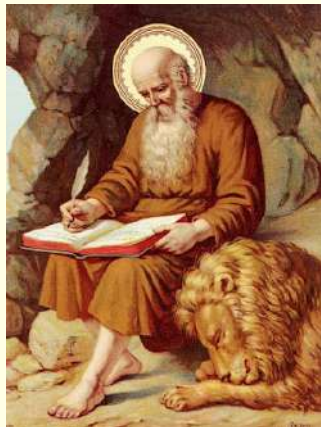
Sunday, June 11, 2023

- ◇ Turn left onto Farragut Road and proceed west to East 34<sup>th</sup> Street.
- ◇ Turn left onto East 34<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed south to Avenue H.
- ◇ Turn left onto Avenue H and proceed east to Brooklyn Avenue.
- ◇ Turn left onto Brooklyn Avenue and proceed north to Glenwood Road.
- ◇ Turn right onto Glenwood Road and proceed to Saint Vincent Ferrer at East 37<sup>th</sup> Street.





## The Eucharist Is The Heart Of Our Life In Christ



**The Gospel according to Saint Mark** is generally recognized as the first text to be called a Gospel, “the Good News.” Both Matthew and Luke drew from Mark’s work as they wrote their versions. The fact that the work of these disciples is called “Good News” reminds us that Jesus came to reveal

God’s great love and mercy. Like the first disciples, we are called to “Go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature.” To do that effectively, we must take the inspired texts deeply into our hearts.

Do we read the bible regularly and ponder God’s words to us? Mark’s gospel is the shortest one. Have you ever sat down and read it straight through? Reading the whole text puts it into context and often reveals new insights.

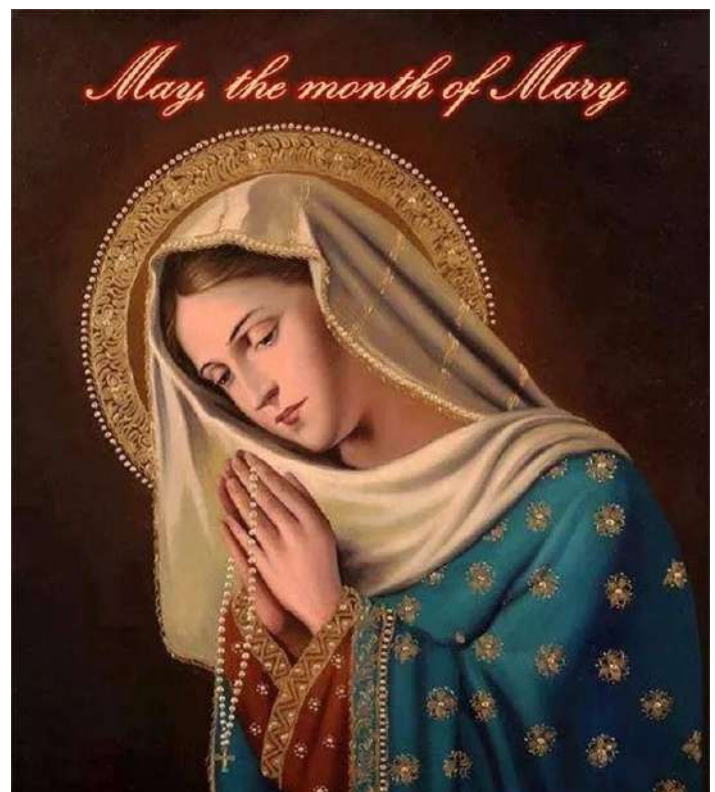

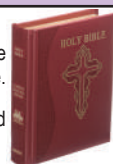
