With hospitality and affection (1b), Elizabeth greets her cousin Mary (2), the bearer of the Mighty Savior (1a, Ps).

**Thursday:** Sir 42:15-25; Ps 33:2-9; Mk 10:46-52.  
By the word of the Lord all creation is filled with glory (1, Ps). Because of his faith, the blind beggar is healed (2).

**Friday:** Sir 44:1, 9-13; Ps 149:1b-6a, 9b; Mk 11:11-26.  
The Lord takes delight in his people (Ps), especially in those who led virtuous lives and whose names live on forever (1). Jesus drives out those who have made the temple a “den of thieves,” and exhorts his disciples to have faith in God and to forgive others (2).

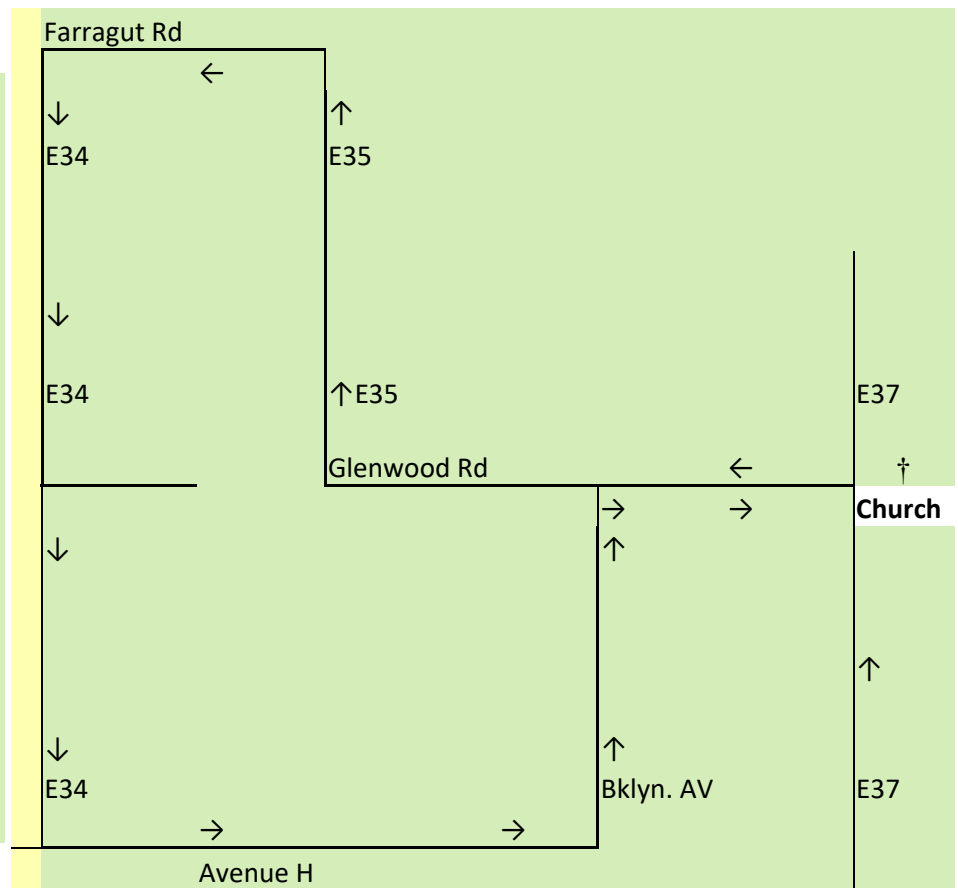

- ◇ Turn left onto Farragut Road and proceed west to East 34<sup>th</sup> Street.
- ◇ Turn left onto East 34<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed south to Avenue H.
- ◇ Turn left onto Avenue H and proceed east to Brooklyn Avenue.
- ◇ Turn left onto Brooklyn Avenue and proceed north to Glenwood Road.
- ◇ Turn right onto Glenwood Road and proceed to Saint Vincent Ferrer at East 37<sup>th</sup> Street.

## The Eucharist Is The Heart Of Our Life In Christ

### The Real Miracle of Pentecost

Without question, the most famous passage in Acts is the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles at Pentecost. (2:1-13). The description of the Spirit is vague and mysterious. The real miracle of Pentecost is found in the transformation of the apostles. They are now ready to begin their mission. Empowered by the Spirit, they have been transformed and can now proclaim the mighty works of God (vv. 4, 11).

Yet, even with the Spirit's power, God's mission can never be imposed upon anyone. Those who hear the apostles must choose to believe. This is why Luke ends the scene with a humorous comment: Every person must decide whether what they see and hear before them comes from God's Spirit or "too much wine" (v. 13).

The gift of the Spirit comes to us as individuals. The personal gift of the Spirit does not negate the communal nature of the church. The unique gifts of each individual are essential in spreading God's reign.

Our gifts are not the same. Some are dramatic and others unassuming. Some may be tied to intellectual prowess and others to matters of the heart. Some – teaching, preaching, and athletic abilities – can be immediately seen. Others are more hidden, such as the gift to recognize another's pain or the patience to listen when a hurting friend needs to vent. The church is impoverished whenever we fail to use the gifts we have been given. At Pentecost, each disciple was marked with his or her individual flame. If the gospel is to spread to the ends of the earth, we must each find our particular fire and use it.

Acts of the Apostles give us a portrait of the early church that is raw, conflicted, complex, and filled with uncertainty. It reminds us of the world in which we live. A theme running throughout Acts, is the perpetual coexistence of struggle and hope. This is an enduring lesson for us. Christian joy is not the absence of pain but the transformation of it. Only a belief and world view truly gets it – that is, one that compassionately recognizes, comprehends, and accompanies the trauma found in so much of our own common human experience – is capable of simultaneously finding great joy. Pain is not a prerequisite for joy nor negates it. Great joy can be found when we set out, as the early apostles did, on this journey of human solidarity.

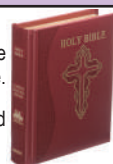
