Is 49:1-6, Ps 139:1b-3, 13-15, Acts 13: 22-26, Lk 1:57-66, 80. Called from birth by the Lord (1, Ps), John (= “God is gracious”) matured in the spirit (3) and heralded the advent of the Messiah.

The Twelve

In Sunday’s Gospel we hear of the choosing of “the Twelve.” The first on the list will deny him, the last will betray him, and the rest apparently flee in fear upon arrest. As is often the case, however, this narrative has more to teach us.

Let us first notice the setting. Just after a short passage that summarizes Jesus’ healing ministry, the text says Jesus filled with “compassion” because he saw the crowds as “sheep without a shepherd.” Jesus invites his followers to address this situation by asking the “master of the harvest” (God) to send more laborers. Only then does he assemble his “twelve disciples” for what remarkably follows. He shares his own “authority” with them, which conspicuously includes several types of healing. The text then list these Twelve who are suddenly called *apostles* for they are *sent out* on mission. In Matthew, the list is striking, Simon Peter is literally designated “first,” and Judas Iscariot, the betrayer, appears last. In between are pairs of brothers and individuals, including “Matthew the tax collector,” whose call is described earlier (Matt 9:9-13).

Most impressively, these Twelve – a symbolic number who are meant to judge the reconstituted twelve tribes of Israel (Matt 19:28) - are specifically of the sent to the “lost sheep of the house of Israel.” The apostles are to become good shepherds for a needy flock. After the resurrection, they ae sent out by the risen Jesus on a worldwide mission, to “all nations” Matt 28:19-20. That same ministry continues in the Church’s mission today.

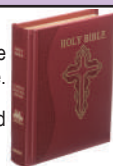
