### **Read the Gospel of the day,**

Take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:

- What word or words in this passage caught your attention?
- What in this passage comforted you?
- What in this passage challenged you?

### **Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

Gn 3:9-15; Ps 130:1-8; 2Cor 4:13-5:1; Mk 3:20-35.  
With the Lord there is mercy and redemption (Ps) for the reign of sin (1) has come to an end in the person of Jesus (3). Hence we must never lose heart for we believe we shall be raised up with him. (2).

### **Monday:**

1 Kgs 17:1-6; Ps 121:1b-8; Mt 5:1-12. Elijah receives help from the Lord (Ps) who provides him with food and drink (1). Blest are the poor in spirit (2).

### **Tuesday:**

Acts 11:21b-26, 13:1-3; Ps 98:1-6Mt 5:3-16.  
Along with Paul, Barnabas is set apart (1) to preach the good news to the nations (Ps). His light shone before others, glorifying our heavenly Father (2).

### **Wednesday:**

1 Kgs 18:20-39; Ps 16:1-2, 4-5, 8, 11. Mt 5:17-19.  
Elijah is faithful to the God of Israel (1), refusing to court other gods (Ps). Jesus came to fulfil the law (2).

### **Thursday:**

1 Kgs 18:41-46; Ps 65:10-13; Mt 5:20-26.  
Elijah intercedes on behalf of the people (1) and the rains fall (Ps). To be holy we must forgive one another (2).

### **Friday:**

1 Kgs 19:9a, 1-16; Ps 27:7-9c, 13-14; Mt 5:29-32.  
God is revealed to Elijah in new, unexpected ways (1, Ps). Jesus reveals his new commandment regarding conjugal love (2).

### **Saturday:**

1 Kgs 19:19-21; Ps 16:1b-2a, 5, 7-10; Mt 5:33-37.  
Elijah chooses Elisha as his servant and disciple (1). The disciple of Jesus, possessed by the Spirit, bears witness to the truth (2). In the Lord is our refuge (Ps).

### *Scripture Reflection*

**Read Sunday's Gospel:** Mark 3:20-35

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

***Again the crowd gathered, making it impossible for them even to eat.*** What obstacles prevent me from drawing close to Jesus? How can I help others draw closer to Jesus?

***And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand.*** How can I be a peacemaker in my family, my parish, and my community? How can I repair the broken relationships in my life?

***For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.*** How can I find a community that will help me grow in faith? How can the Church respond to the voice of the Holy Spirit in following the synodal way?

After a period of silent reflection recite the Lord's Prayer.

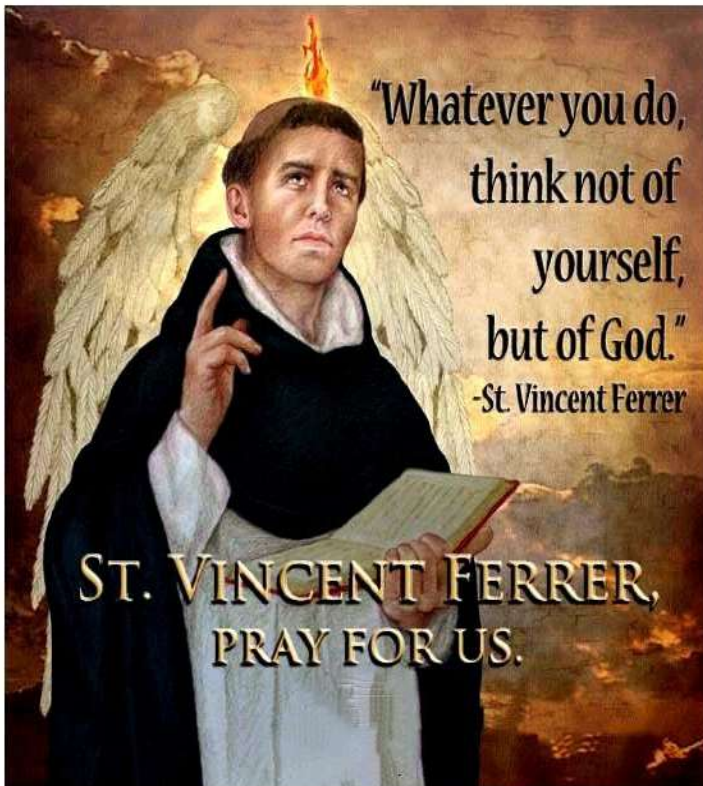

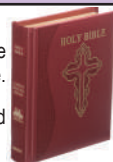
